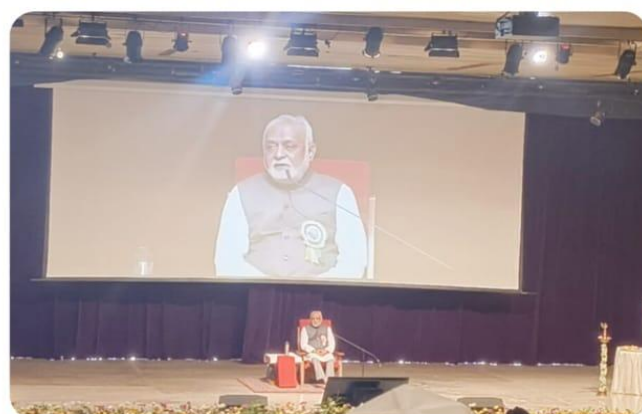
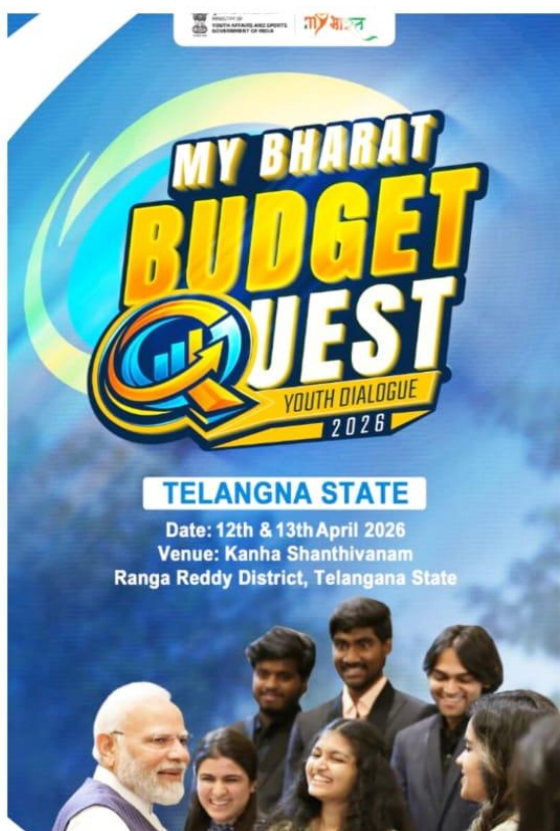


February 2026
